

There are two types of vehicles you can use:

Taxis

Private Hire Vehicles





Taxis

- You can stop a taxi in the street by holding out your arm
- You can find taxis waiting at taxi ranks
- In Bournemouth these vehicles will be yellow, or if wheelchair accessible may be black
- Taxis will have a TAXI roof sign on top of the vehicle



Private Hire Vehicles

- You must phone up or go to a private hire office to book one of these. Tell them:
 - ✓ your name
 - ✓ the time you want the cab
 - ✓ where you are and where you want to go
 - ✓ ask how much it will cost

- When the vehicle arrives ask the driver if the vehicle is for you.
- DO NOT get into the vehicle if it is not booked for you
- These vehicles should have yellow signs by the door handles which say 'No Booking, No Ride'

NO BOOKING NO RIDE

REMEMBER

When travelling in a taxi or private hire vehicle:

- Put your seatbelt on
- > Sit in the back of the vehicle
- Don't talk to the driver about private things
- Have your money ready when you get near where you're going
- If someone you don't know stops to ask you directions or offers you a lift, never get into the car with them or any stranger.

If a driver is rude to you, or overcharges you, or you wish to complain about the journey:

- Try to get the vehicle registration
- Try to get the drivers name
- Note down the time and date
